There is still much to do in the fight for education equity. Communication with families, expectations of children, assumptions about access and what counts as learning reveal yet more equity gaps.

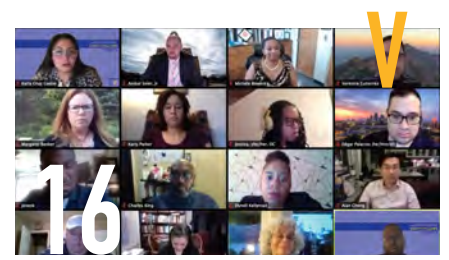
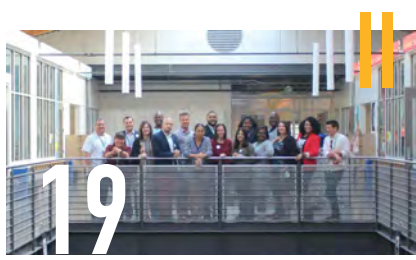

CELEBRATING SIX YEARS, FIVE COHORTS, 75 FELLOWS



The Equity Fellowship is a 24-month cohort-based leadership program that aims to strengthen and sustain diverse and exceptional leaders who will influence the policies and practices which expand access to deep learning in public education across the country. With support from the Hewlett Foundation, the Equity Fellowship began in 2015 with a cohort of 9 fellows and currently serves 75 Fellows across five cohorts.

- 1 Create and support a community of Fellows who serve as activist champions, individually and collectively, for equitable access to deeper learning.
- 2 Support fellows in creating action-oriented projects that support the design and implementation of policies, programs and practices that provide equitable access to deep learning, particularly for those students who have been denied such opportunities.
- 3 Increase the number of districts, schools, classrooms and educators led by equity-focused leaders, thereby increasing access to deep learning for those students targeted by Fellows in their Fellowship projects.
